Snow Season

We can have big snowstorms in the Brazos. Be prepared to be unable to get to your cabin, be snowed in, and maybe have power outages. Our snow removal contractor normally has our roads plowed within 12 hours after a storm. His first priority is full time EAR residents, then the rest of our roads.

Water Notes

- Always have extra water at your cabin for emergencies in case of a water outage.
- Please turn off the water to your cabin when you leave. If you do not have a separate water shutoff you will need to install one.
- Do not use the EAR water meter to shut off water at your cabin.
- Contact us to turn water off at the meter.



Water and Water Lines

Prior to working on water lines at your cabin, please notify us. While you are responsible for your water lines beyond the meter, some lines are complicated. Do not do any work on EAR water lines. If EAR water lines are damaged by you or your contractor, it is a tremendous burden on your neighbors and you will be responsible for repairs.
